*Terroir de Granit bears the identity and the character of Saint Joseph: red fruit, terroir, tight tannins, beautiful structure and freshness.*



### THE WINE

Terroir de Granit is a wine made with 60 years old vines on granitic soils around the town of Saint Jean de Muzols.

### THE VINTAGE

2017 – The Rhône valley was one of the only regions of France that was spared by the frost and hail in 2017. It is already considered as a great vintage, even in his early years.

### SITUATION

Saint Jean de Muzols Village

### TERROIR

Granitique

### WINEMAKING

2 months with whole stem (about 60%) - Refueling and shedding daily - Indigenous yeast

### MATURATION

Used old oak barrels with 400 liters of capacity.  
12 Months of growing in barrels and 2 months in vat

### VARIETALS

Syrah : 100%

### SPECIFICATIONS

Alcohol level : 14 % vol.  
Farming Label: Agriculture Raisonnée Volume  
Production : 190 hL

### TASTING NOTES

Color: Ruby color, tawny and purple reflection  
Nose: Accomplished expression of spicy notes, and balsamic.  
Mouth: A contrasting aromatic taste, the chocolate velvet.

Nice for your grilled meats, tagines of lamb, cuts of beef with Béarnaise sauce.
