Château de Ruth stands in Sainte-Cécile-les-Vignes, to the north-east of Orange in heart of southern Rhone Valley. The domain is one of the oldest in the Rhone Valley, its name first appeared in 1561. It shelters, under Louis XIV, a convent of which remains the remains. Vincent Moreau fell under the charms of this beautiful property on an exceptional terroir and quality of this vineyard, he bought it in 2010. He devotes all his know-how and enthusiasm to produce quality wines from the exceptional terroir of red clays and river stones

Southern Rhone Valley 2020 vintage : 2020 is an early and heterogeneous vintage. Rain in fall built up water reserves for a dry and mild winter. Bud break started early in spring. Sunny summer days were balanced with cool nights. Some rain spell in August encouraged the fruit to develop well. Grapes were harvested in an excellent sanitary state.

Grape varieties : Syrah 50%, Marselan 50%
Harvested in August 26, 2020
Vines age : 8 years on average
Pruning : Cordon de Royat
Vines orientation : South
Yield : 60hl/h

Farming practice : sustainable certified HEV certification level 3

Soil : Clay-limestone soil

Winemaking : Thermo-regulated tanks and pre-fermentation maceration

Tasting notes : Bright red color. Floral fresh nose. Aromas of red berries on the palate.

Suggested food pairing : aperitif, white and red meat, poultry
